### Green Building Rating System for New Construction & Major Renovations USGBC LEED Certification (LEED-NC) Version 2.2 for Particleboard and Medium Density Fiberboard

Flakeboard particleboard (PB) and medium density fiberboard (MDF) are manufactured to strict quality control standards with recycled and recovered wood fiber. These products may contribute towards specific credits under the US Green Building Council (USGBC) Leadership in Energy & Environmental Design (LEED) criteria. The following credits are recognized under the LEED Green Building Rating System for New Construction & Major Renovations, Version 2.2, October, 2005:

- **Materials & Resources, Recycled Content, Credits 4.1 and 4.2.**  
All Flakeboard PB/MDF products are manufactured from 100% pre and/or post consumer (recycled and/or recovered fiber).
- **Materials & Resources, Regional Materials, Credits 5.1 and 5.2.** \*  
Flakeboard PB/MDF products are manufactured in eight locations in North America: New Brunswick and Ontario, Canada; Oregon, Arkansas, Louisiana, and South Carolina, USA. All of the wood fiber used is recycled or recovered from within a 100 mile radius of the manufacturing facilities. These facilities are within 500 miles of a significant portion of the US population.
